

Short Term Mission Committee

- ➤ The IC1301 COST has 7 STMS for this year
- ➤ We already received 5 applications (4 for this year)

Budget Constraints


In this meeting not all potential participants could be reimbursed, priority was given to MC Members.

Possibilities for handling this (proposed by the COST Office):

- Negotiate special rates with hotels and lower accommodation flat rate in advance to the meeting (e.g. not 120 but 80 EUR).
- Set deadlines for MC member to accept invitation. After deadline the budget is freed to support other researchers than MC members.
- Introduce a ceiling (must be in line with accommodation flat rate rules,
 but can make a cut on reimbursement of travel expenses).

Topic: Bottom-up space technologies at low TRL COMPET-03-2015

Proposals based on low TRL[1] (1-3) ideas and technologies which could have a final application in future Space systems are solicited. The target is to demonstrate them up to TRL (4-5). In this first call, proposals on the fundamental areas of knowledge are foreseen, in which for example some of the Key Enabling Technologies (KETs) are playing a major role. In particular, proposals are sought with relevance for the fields of: "energy storage", "energy production", "materials and structures", "additive layer manufacturing techniques", "mechanisms", "wireless power transmission", "high performance and reliable electronics to boost on-board power", and "thermal control management systems" in the domain of space.
